



**Bitburger Drive, Germany, 0% £2.10**

The impressive taste is due to the unique way in which Bitburger Drive Alkoholfrei is produced. It is brewed in exactly the same way as the full strength Bitburger Pilsner beer, making it the best-tasting low alcohol beer on the market today. Only when the beer has matured completely is the alcohol removed using an extremely gentle process so Bitburger retains all the qualities of a premium beer

**Blue Moon, USA 5.4% £3.95**

Citrusy sweet nose, spicy with notes of orange and coriander. Some wheat sourness, finishing on the sweet side.

**Budvar, Czech Republic 5% £3.40**

Medium golden colour beer with a perfumed floral note with a gentle grassy hoppiness emerges

**Bulmers Crisp Blend, England 4.5% £4.70**

Bulmers uses only the finest apples to deliver a premium quality cider, which is vat matured to give Bulmers its natural refreshing taste and smooth character

**Brooklyn Lager, USA 5.2% £3.95**

Amber gold, with a malty body and floral hop character, it is a revival of Brooklyn's pre-prohibition all malt beers. Delicious, dry, full-flavoured, aromatically hopped lager

**Coopers Pale Ale, Australia 4.5% £3.90**

This bottle-fermented beer cascades into the glass in a great swirling cloud of yeasty, ginger-beer-coloured bubbles. The nose has caramel and a light iodine note, and a dry hoppiness. On the palate it is quite light, with a smooth texture and good flavour, without being particularly distinctive. Dry and well-balanced

**Coopers Sparkling Ale, Australia 5.8%     £3.90**

This pours in a cloud of darker, gold/bronze with quite a tight, just off-white head. The nose is lovely, with a little hint of cinnamon, fine hops and fruity notes. On the palate it is medium-bodied and smooth, with a rich moussy attack, and subtly toasty character. It is a very classy beer, with a tight-grained, bitter hoppiness and a lovely focus of quite fruity, herbal flavours and that subtle toast held in check

**Courage Light Ale, England 3.2%                     £3.65**

Clear shear gold with a slight head, sweet hoppy aroma. Light but malty beer, with honey tones running through. Slightly fruity on the nose, a satisfying blend of malt and hops, more bitter than your average light ale

**Crown Lager, Australia 4.9%                             £3.80**

Australia's premium beer, is based on the finest malt, sugar, hops, and brewing yeast. A lightly coloured, but full flavoured lager, it has a fine balance of malt character, clean hop bitterness and a slight sweetness on the palate. The aroma is a blend of hoppy, malty and fruity/yeasty notes

**Duvel, Belgium 8.5%                                         £4.70**

Duvel is unique. No other beer is made like it, or tastes like it. Blonde and refreshing like a Pilsner, but with the flavour, depth and complexity of an Ale. Duvel defines the Strong Golden Ale category. The beer's golden hues originate with its Pilsner malts, while Bohemian hops and unique yeast strain add character, intensity and a certain verve. It's the beguiling nature that has made Duvel a long time Belgian favourite

**Fruli Strawberry, Belgium 4.1%                         £3.50**

Fruli is a high quality Belgian white beer blended with pure fruit juice. The strawberry juice compliments the zesty fruitiness of the wheat beer

**Heineken, Netherlands 5.0% £3.50**

Pouring a pale golden colour this beer has a clean maltiness in the nose, a little herbal aroma, a flowery hop, and brief hints of fruitiness that is not quite deep enough to define itself.

The palate is nothing too demanding, light, but with a spritzy carbonation providing for a nice crisp sharpness

**Innis & Gunn oak aged beer, Scotland 6.6% £3.90**

This strong malt, has toffee sweetness and notes of oak and vanilla. Although well balanced and sweet, floral touched blend themselves into the strong honey flavour. Due to being aged in ex bourbon barrels there is a smoky tone to this beer. It is also very hoppy and perfectly carbonated- not too much, not too little

**James Boags, Tasmania 5% £3.80**

The ingredients, water, barley, hops and yeast - all from the only place that is possible, Tasmania. A lager that sources it ingredients from the island and is brewed with no preservatives and no artificial additives to ensure it is the closest thing to purity. Pure in taste, pure in ingredients, pure by nature.

Clear ale, slightly bitter, no aftertaste

**Jeremiah Weed Sour Mash Brew, USA 4% £4.55**

An American beer blended with fruit alcohol and bourbon

**Jeremiah Weed Root Brew, USA 4% £4.55**

A beer from the 1980s with some level of notoriety comes from the hills of Eastern Kentucky and East Tennessee. Available in Root Brew and Sour Mash Flavour

**Konig Ludwig, Germany 5.5% £4.50**

This slightly cloudy beer hones fresh citrus, orange and grapefruit smells. Its sweet body captures the wheatyness of the

beer alongside an orange and slight banana flavour. With a crisp and slightly tart finish, you are left with a slight sour lime taste. This light and refreshing fruity beer is an excellent summer beverage

**Liefmans Cuvee Brut, Belgium 6% £6.15**

Pour is deep ruby red with a large pink head that settles very quickly. Aroma is of sour cherries, fruit syrup, citrus, earth. Flavour is light and refreshing with a clear tart cherry flavour with more subtle hints of some darker fruits. Sour/acidic finish, but well balanced. Light bodied

**Little Creature Pale Ale, Australia 5.2% £3.90**

Fresh hop Flowers are carefully selected that are bursting with aroma and contain all the essential oils and acids that deliver an unique flavour experience. Crisp citrus flavours of grapefruit and passion fruit and trickle of honey, all backed up with a good balance of bitterness. Selected malts are kilned in small batches to our specifications and are used exclusively in this pale ale. Two different yeasts are used to both ferment and bottle condition the beer

**Macs Gold, New Zealand 4% £3.45**

Brewed without artificial influence since 1983, its delicate caramel sweetness and crisp, clean aftertaste allow it to be one of New Zealand's best malt brews. Although it has a slight bitterness and hints of citrus, this brew is easy drinking and perfect with chicken and fish dishes

**Moosehead, Canada 5% £3.55**

Subtle grassy aroma, lemony hops, straw, and mineral water are present within this Canadian beer. Opens crisp and mildly hoppy with notes of biscuits, grass, straw, lemon, and minerals. The

finish is clipped and gently hoppy with a combination of lemon and grass flavours. Light-to-medium bodied, crisp and dry with active carbonation

**Palm, Belgium 5.4% £3.70**

Palm is Belgium's amber beer. The special malt gives honey like mellowness, its own yeasts provide a fruity aroma, and the aroma hop, grown in Kent, gives it a refined character

**Peroni, Italy 5.1% £3.50**

Peroni Nastro Azzurro is an intensely crisp and refreshing lager with an unmistakable touch of Italian style brewed in Italy to the original recipe conceived in 1963. Crisp and lightly sparkling, its unique taste is refreshing and dry with a clear-cut, clean character

**Rekorderlig Winter Apple, Sweden 4% £4.70**

Freshly cut apple nose, semi-sweet palate with strong fresh apple notes finishing with almost no acidity. Serve over ice to reduce sweetness

**Rekorderlig Strawberry and Lime, Sweden 4% £4.70**

The nose of fresh market strawberry's. On the palate, these two flavours combine perfectly for an amazingly refreshing taste. Semi-sweet and pouring pink into the glass Rekorderlig Strawberry & Lime should be tried over Ice, with fresh mint

**Rekorderlig Wild Berries, Sweden 4% £4.70**

The nose of fresh, juicy wild country berries with the subtle undertones of the Pear base combine wondrously in this semi-sweet cider to produce a slightly drier finish on the palate. Pour chilled straight onto ice or mix a handful of Raspberries and Blueberries (fresh or frozen) with crushed ice for extra indulgence

**Rekorderlig Pear, Sweden 4.5%** **£4.70**

Fresh pear nose. Semi-sweet palate with strong fresh pear notes and hints of vanilla finishing in a Semi-tart back palate with low acidity. Serve over ice and add lemon to promote tart back palate or Lime to induce strong vanilla tones

**Sagres, Portugal 5.1%** **£3.50**

This reddish/black beer has a sturdy beige bubbled froth. Its slight dusty and chocolate malt is easy on the tongue but is still quite bitter and slightly sour.

**Savanna Cider, South Africa 5.5%** **£3.50**

Savanna Dry is a clear 100% apple cider in a unique see through bottle and made from the juice of gorgeous South African apples which are grown in Elgin, a lush region of the Western Cape. The magic of transforming humble apple juice into sublime cider is all in the fermentation process

**Sierra Nevada, USA 5.6%** **£4.50**

Sierra Nevada Pale ale is enticing American Pale ale, a delightful interpretation of a classic style. It has a deep amber color and an exceptionally full-bodied, complex character. Generous quantities of premium Cascade hops give the Pale Ale its fragrant bouquet and spicy flavour. Sierra Nevada Pale Ale is the flagship beer, the one that made Chico famous. It is a flawless beer that opens with bright, perky high notes of maltiness and orange blossom and segues into a delectable hoppiness

**Sol, Mexico 4.5%** **£3.35**

Taste is grainy but with a little citrus note coming through. There's also a slight hop bitterness in the finish. This beer is crisp, clean, and very smooth

**Stienlager pure, New Zealand 5% £3.40**

Mild malty aroma with a bit of grainy sweetness and fruity character. Pale in colour with a very slight sweetness and a faint bitterness. Well balanced and finishes crisply, has a light body and a high level of carbonation that gives it a slight bite

**Tiger, Singapore 4.8% £3.35**

The fresh flavour and mild aftertaste of tiger beer makes it the perfect remedy to the hot and humid weather, as of that in its homeland, South East Asia. When served chilled the silky texture of Tiger beer turns crisp, providing a refreshing contrast to the spicier dishes of Thailand and Malaysia, while the malt and honey tones in the body of the beer are light enough to complement even the most delicate Asian flavours

**Tooheys New, Australia 4.6% £3.65**

This smooth and refreshing beer has a very easy drinking taste. Its lightly hopped, malty character delivers the perfect balance of bitter and sweet beer flavours. It is low in effervescence to enhance refreshment - ensuring that each sip tastes as good as the first

**Tooheys extra dry, Australia 5% £3.45**

Wonderful fruity beer, slightly malty notes that accompany a mellow middle palate. A clean aftertaste with this Australian dry beer

**Vedett White, Belgium 4.7% £3.85**

Vedett Extra White has a delicious refreshing taste, surprisingly crisp punctuated with an orange and lemon like zest, rounded with a mildly bitter taste and dry finish

**Vedett Blonde, Belgium 5.2% £3.85**
